

Suzuki & Co. The Rice Riots of 1918 and burning of Suzuki headquarters






















Theviolentmob raided, looted, and ultimately set fire Suzukisheadquarters burning the building to the ground.

> > On August 22, Suzuki's Uwajima sake plant in Ehime prefecture was attacked.


Suzuki & Co. sustained major damages to its facilities as a result of the riots.
